STATEMENT OF INTENT

During my studies in "Arts et métiers de la danse" I had to leave my Lorraine region and particularly Audun-le-Tiche in order to allow me to develop and improve my dance skills.

It quickly became clear to me that there was a lack of connection between amateur and professional environment.

It is in that context that after obtaining my "Diplome d'Etat", I returned to Audun-le-Tiche to create Chor'A Corps association.

My objective was of course to promote to amateur artistic education through dance lessons but also to create some bridges with professional world of dance. It is important to me to direct them towards the discovery of the culture in general and what could be better than to use the art that I have in my heart?

Over the years, we have created an advanced section for students wishing to become even more intensely involved in the dance world. We moved forward in this improvement by participating in choreographic championship organized by the FFD (French Dance Federation) where we can share our experience and creation with professional choreographers.

Our reputation then led us to participate in a multitude of cultural projects, including "Rodina" in 2018 which permits our dancers to discover a part of the tragic history of our territory during the Occupation period.

Over the years, I have built up a network of professional choreographers which give me the opportunity today to organize for our students one-off internships of advanced training with professionals known around the world.

Continuously looking for new challenges I would like my students to (re) discover dance with completely shaken up codes: dancing in weightlessness, and defy gravity laws. The "Hauts fourneaux de Belval" are a suitable location for this project which will allow beyond the artistic performance to bring awareness to them of the historical side of this building that they see daily without really knowing its story.

Carl Portal, choreographer of the musical comedy "Romeo and Juliet", ex dancer in various musicals accepted to collaborate with me in order to explore this challenge together..

PROJECT

Step 1: Hauts Fourneaux meeting

The objective of this 1st step was to discover this atypical environment and the possibilities for us to welcome our aerobatic dancers.

Two meetings have already taken place on site with Carl Portal, choreographer of the project, Aurélien Quiévreux, technical director, members of Esch2022 team and the management team of the "Hauts fourneaux de Belval".

These two visits allowed us to visualize the possible hooks for the dancers and also all the technical constraints in terms of budget to carry out the artistic creation which will be composed by three professional dancers and amateur dancers from our association.

We are currently reflecting on the way to add music to the performance can for example be through a headphone system; the idea would be to push the innovation of this project to its maximum both visually and sound wise.

Step 2: Choreographic creation

The rehearsal will take place at the Arche (Pôle Culturel de Micheville) and to the extent possible at the "Hauts fourneaux de Belval" depending of the availability of the place.

It will consist of several weeks of work with Carl Portal and his professional team*:

- -From Monday December 27 to Thursday December 30, 2021
- -From Monday February 07 to Friday February 11,2022
- -From Monday April 11 to Friday April 15, 2022
- -From Thursday May 26 to Sunday May 29, 2022
- -From Saturday June 4 to Monday June 6,2022

The objective of this step is the creation of the choreographic piece which will mix amateur and professional dancers.

It is therefore imperative that we are welcomed in an appropriate place for setting up students in good situation.

Amateur and professional artists will be put in a situation of weightlessness from the first repetitions.

In order for this to be possible, for each week of rehearsal, we will have to rent technical equipment allowing us to suspend the artist. At least two technicians must be present to manage and direct the motors.

At the end of the 5 creation sessions, the choreography will have taken shape and will be in position to be presented to the public.

During the 2nd step, open doors or public rehearsals can be offered to spectators to see the evolution of the creation.

Step 3 : Public performance

Step 3 is the finale point of this project.

The choreographic piece will then be presented to the public during one or more evenings at the "Coulées dans les hauts-Fourneaux d'Esch Belval".

This step will be preceded by several days of rehearsals as well as one ore dress rehearsals:

-From 20 to 21 June, 2022: assembly and technical preparation

-From June 21 to 23 June, 2022 : rehearsal days

-June 24, 2022 : dress rehearsals

-June 26 and 27, 2022 : shows



Every 3 years, a show is presented at the Esch/Alzette theatre with all the dancers. Here in 2017, 4-5 years old dancers in the interpretation of the iron lumberjacks in the show "Dorothy and the Magician Oz" directed by Aurélie Gelmi.

BIOGRAPHIES

CHOR'A CORPS

The Dance association/school Chor'A Corps was founded July 1, 2010 affiliated at the Federation Française de Danse since the first day.

Dance classes are open from the age of 4 where we offer dance, pilates and yoga courses.

There are 2 types of courses within our school:

- -Leisure course with a end of year show every 3 years at the Esch/Alzette theater
- -Advanced course for students to participate in different dance competitions

The association also organizes several dance and yoga interships in Audun-le-Tiche during the season with guests, often international choreographers who are also open to students outside the association.

The association has 2 employees (Océane Presutti and Aurélie Gelmi) and a yoga instructor (Yves Fattorelli).

In 2015, 2 choreographies signed Aurélie Gelmi obtained a medal of bronze at the French national choreographic championship organized by the FFD ("Céleste" in teenager category and "Manie Dansante" in youth category)

In 2016, a student of the association became Champion of France in Jazz dance

In 2017, Alexia Szylar won a gold medal in solo category at the French national choreographic championship organized by the FFD with "Sensis" by Aurélie Gelmi

In 2018, Mélanie Donjon, student of our association obtained a silver medal medal in solo category at the French national choreographic championship organized by the FFD

Chor'A Corps also participated in a show with the company Memoire Vive (CCPHVA co-production) entitled "Rodina".

In 2019, the choreography "La Tresse" by Aurélie Gelmi obtained a bronze medal at the French national choreographic championship organized by the FFD in youth category.

In 2020, Mélissa Gautherin, student for 10 years in our association won for the 2nd time the title of French Jazz champion in youth category at the Metz opera theater.



Since summer 2011, Chor'Acorp has it own premises, thus enabling the time suitable for dancers. In September 2019, the dance studio has moved to rue du Laboratoire in Audun le Tiche



In 2019, 2 dancers from the association obtained respectively a title of Champion de France in Adult category for Frédéric Dessi (photo above) and Vice-championne de france in Youth category for Mélissa Gautherin

CARL PORTAL, chorégraphe

Native from the south of France, Carl Portal started his career very young at the regional conservatory of Montpellier.

At 17 he joined the professional courses of the Rick Odums center in Paris where he obtained his "Diplome d'Etat" as a dance teacher. Since then he is solicited to deliver courses in different school dance for several years in France but also around the world (South Korea, Algeria, Sweden, Italy, Poland, etc)

He dances in companies in France and abroad with renowned choreographers such as Geraldine Amstrong, Thierry Verger, Bruce Taylor, Rick Odums, Bruno Collinet, Sylvie Lequeré, Anne-Marie Porras, the band Linga Dance Project, Kamel Ouali, Bruno Agati but also as soloist for the Marie Claude Pietragalla band.

Thanks to his various experiences acquired in the different musical comedies like "Notre Dame de Paris", "Roméo & Juliette", "Autant en emporte le vent", "Un air de Paris" with Patrick Dupond and the comic opera "Mistinguette" by Jerome Savary who will end up developing his talents as a young choreographer in his own school dance Carl Portal.

He participated in many festivals and TV shows such as Star Academy and also in different entertainment programs.

Carl also evolves in other domains such as fashion week with Yohji Yamamoto and jean Paul Gauthier.

In 2011, he participated in the AMICI progam, a program broadcast on the Italian TV where Carl was choreographer and jury member at all prime time.

In 2012, he was the choreographer in contemporary category of the program "You can dance", the Star Academy program broadcast on NT1.

In 2018, he was the choreographer and Artistic Director of the new show of Gerard Presgurvic "Paris sur Seine".

Since 2017, he is the Artistic Director of the summer intership MDC83 created in 2018 where was created the Young companies competition "For everyone their place".



Since 2010 Carl Portal has choreographed and created the new version of Romeo & Juliet from Gérard Presgurvic at Palais des Congrès in Paris. Show is currently on tourin Japan, China, Russia and South Korea

AURÉLIEN QUIÉVREUX, directeur technique

After a few years spent in the backstage at one of the largest French technical service provider, Aurélien started his career in preparing, repairing and organizing departures and returns of services. This is how he was able to rub shoulders with many show in freelancers who allowed him to continue to train and learn the tricks of the business.

He had the chance to work on festivals and concerts in particular with Ricard Live Music, Solidays, Dours festival, Rock en seine, tout le monde chante, Nordik Impact and others.

Thus, he had the chance to work with artists such as Mary J Blidge, Patrick Bruel, Charlie Winston, Trust, Parabelum or even Indochine.

As a result of these many live experience, Aurélien wanted to mix all the trades and then became interested in Circus arts. This is how is was able to join technical teams on projects with Cirque Phenix, Cirque du soleil and schools of the Seine-sur-Mer circus.

The technical combination of circus arts and live performance has quickly directed to the field of musicals which according to him, brings together all artistic professions in a single one project.

He therefore joined the technical teams of large productions such as Dirty Dancing, Soy de Cuba, Ballet Revoluccion and Béjart ballets as technical director.



Aurélien is currently the technical director on an equestrian show in Kazakhstan. As part as his mandate he travels around the world especially in Asian countries with Carl Portal with Romeo & Juliet musical comedy
